DAN KENNARD TO RETIRE FROM HANCOCK FEDERAL CREDIT UNION

Hancock Federal Credit Union has announced that Dan Kennard, current President/CEO, will retire on December 31, 2020 after 41 years in the banking industry. Kennard has served in his position at HFCU since December 2010.

During Kennard's tenure as President/CEO, he has played a critical role in overseeing the growth of HFCU's overall assets, membership, deposits and lending areas that include consumer, mortgage and small business lending. Under his management, the Credit Union has increased its assets by \$31 million and had phenomenal growth in the lending area by over 106% or \$31 million. With his leadership and guidance, the Credit Union provided its staff and members with a complete remodel of the 125 Trenton Avenue location. Kennard also played an integral part in promoting the 75th anniversary of Hancock Federal Credit Union with many local and state officials in attendance at the ribbon cutting ceremony.

Community is very important to Kennard and he serves on several local board of directors, including the University of Findlay Board of Trustees, College First Church of God Foundation, Blanchard Valley Health System Governance, and he is currently the co-chair of the Backyard Mission Trip of Findlay. He has promoted HFCU throughout the community by supporting local non-profits with major sponsorships in Findlay and the Hancock County area.

"As a board, we are very thankful for Dan's ten years of service to Hancock Federal Credit Union. These years have seen incredible growth in assets and loans and attention on the most important part of the Credit Union – the people. We appreciate his attention to the entire staff and a never-ending focus on our members. We wish him the best in his upcoming retirement," said HFCU Board of Directors Chairperson, Brian Treece.
